Step 3: Collect the documents to support your application including:

- copy of unofficial transcripts
- copy of last report card
- copy of 2022 Federal income tax filing (usually first two pages indicating annual income and dependents)

Step 4: Print and submit your application in person at 6225 Progressive Avenue, Building B suite 100, San Diego CA 92154. Submit your application package any time before the deadline.

High School Boys: September 11, 2023

Step 5: Register for and attend tryouts. All applicants must be present at tryouts. Submitting a scholarship application does not guarantee a spot on a team. Student-athletes must try out and be selected to play for a team to receive a scholarship.
